Career Leap is a government funded program in partnership with Alberta Labour so there are no fees to access our services.

The emPOWER: Women in Trades program is a no-cost government-funded training program, designed in partnership with SAIT to help unemployed or marginally employed women with an interest in entering the trades sector.
